Culture (文化) is learned behavior. Culture includes social and economic systems, marriage customs, religion, philosophy, and all other behaviors that are acquired through the process of learning rather than being instinctual.

There are several traditionally defined areas within biological anthropology, such as primate studies (靈長類學), paleoanthropology, and human variation. Adaptation (適應) can be defined as a set of processes of change and adjustment that increase a population's chances of continuing to exist through successive generations in a given environment. Adaptation occurs within two time frames: short-term adjustments and long-range evolution. The physiological and behavioral adjustments that a person makes in his or her lifetime in response to specific environmental problems are one component of adaptation. When the population itself undergoes genetic or cultural changes that enhance the group's success within its ecological niche or in new niches, it is adapting through evolutionary processes.
